#### **2024 Enrolments**

We have begun accepting enrolments for 2024.

Mr Lukupa and our student councillors visited Hillpark School, Manurewa Central and Everglade school last week to deliver prospectuses. He has also dropped off enrolment packs at Manurewa East School and to some of the other Manurewa Schools who have requested them because they have had some parents asking for them.

If you know of any parents who wants to enrol their child for Year 7 at our school next year, then please do share this information with them!

We have organised two opportunities for prospective parents to visit the school; this will include a tour of classrooms and a presentation about our school, our curriculum and what we do to support a smooth transition from primary to intermediate school. These visits are at the following times:

- this coming Tuesday 1st August 6.30p.m.
- · Wednesday 9th August at 10.30a.m.

Once the form is completed, it is important to also email copies of the birth certificate, passport etc through to the school office.

The enrolment zone will not impact on any enrolments that are received for the START of 2024, so we strongly recommend people get their enrolment forms in this year so students are guaranteed a place. The enrolment zone will come into force from Term 2, 2024.

# It is important to be at school on time!

Learning to manage their time is a necessary life skill for all students particularly as they head off to high school. Parents can support the development of these skills by encouraging students to manage their own time in the morning rather than relying on parents. This includes setting their own alarms to get out of bed, organising all their school stuff BEFORE watching TV etc and sending them off to school with enough time that they are not late!

Last week, we averaged 30 students who were late to school every day!! Most were for unjustified reasons - such as they slept in!!! Of those who were late last week, some were caught wagging down at the shop, or getting off the bus and then heading for the shops instead of coming into school. Others had parents who thought their child was walking straight to school, when in fact they were going via McDonalds and Southmall and then losing track of time.

From now on, we will be contacting parents when students are late to school three times or more so that you know if your child is regularly late and can help us do something about it.

It would be really helpful if parents who are dropping their child off late to school **came in with them to sign them** in as in this way we are able to filter those who are late for genuine reasons.
