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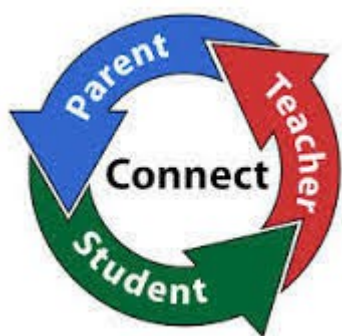
School Buses - Fares Changing

Auckland Transport have asked us to inform parents that the free travel for 5 to 12 year olds and half-price travel for 13 to 24 year olds on Auckland Transport bus, train and ferry services will end on 30 April 2024, in line with the government's decision to withdraw funding for these concessions.



This means that from Wednesday 1 May all students catching the bus will need to pay the child concession rate (40% of an adult fare). They will need to have their hop card topped up so they have sufficient funds to pay the fare.
